




NEW DISCOVERY – ROSS CURLEY – HUMAN VICTIMS OF SOLAR SYSTEM CATASTROPHE



The calcified remains of three victims of the solar system catastrophe of 9,500 BC (*top*) – two adults (*left and bottom center*) and a child (*bottom right*) – lie exposed on an eroding hillside on Mars in this discovery by MARS' Ross Curley. The catastrophe – believed to be caused when debris elements of the *Vela* supernova explosion entered our solar system, fracturing Mars and squishing it into an oblate spheroid – is theorized to have led to massive floods on Mars' surface, trapping the ancient Martians in mud and leaving their fossilized remains when the mud receded.
